Highly motivated students who thrive on academic challenges will flourish in the International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma Programme, an internationally recognized program. The IB Diploma Programme is a comprehensive and challenging pre-university curriculum that demands the best from both motivated students and teachers. Participants will have the advantage of a unique scholarly experience designed to provide a myriad of opportunities for academic expression, while participating in the traditional high school setting.

The IB Programme has three core requirements that are included to broaden the educational experience and challenge students to apply their knowledge and understanding.

The extended essay is a requirement for students to engage in independent research through an in-depth study of a question relating to one of the subjects they are studying.

Theory of knowledge is a course designed to encourage each student to reflect on the nature of knowledge by critically examining different ways of knowing (perception, emotion, language and reason) and different kinds of knowledge (scientific, artistic, mathematical and historical).

Creativity, action, service requires that students actively learn from the experience of doing real tasks beyond the classroom. Students can combine all three components or do activities related to each one of them separately.
