The District offers a Pre-AICE Cambridge Program (also known as Cambridge Lower Secondary Program) at selected middle schools for students who are interested in preparing for the demands and expectations of specialized, advanced academic programs in high school.

Cambridge AICE offers an international pre-university curriculum and examination system, which emphasizes the value of broad and balanced study for academically able students. Cambridge AICE offers students the opportunity to tailor their studies to their individual interests, abilities and future plans within an international curriculum framework.

Cambridge AICE involves the selection of subjects from three curriculum areas—Mathematics and Science; Languages; Arts and Humanities. The Cambridge curriculum aims to encourage the skills of independent research and investigation, the use of initiative and creativity, and the application of skills and knowledge. Many colleges and universities are awarding students advanced standing and academic credit for Cambridge AICE examinations passed.
