

2012-2013 Out-of-Area

Timeline

February 15, 2012	Begin Out of Area Process for Renewal and “ Grandfathered ” Students
March 9, 2012	Deadline for Submitting Renewal and “ Grandfathered ” Out-of-Area Forms to Requested Schools (4:00 p.m.)
March 12, 2012	Begin Out-of-Area Process for New OOA Requests to Attend Requested Schools by Students Attending Brevard Public Schools
April 13, 2012	Deadline for Submitting New Out-of-Area Forms to Assigned Schools by Students that Attended Brevard Public Schools in 2011-2012 Who Wish to Request New School Assignments (4:00 p.m.)
May 7, 2012	Begin Out-of Area Process for New Students to Brevard Public Schools
June 15, 2012	Deadline for Submitting Appeal Forms to the Office of School Choice for Students Who Attended Brevard Public Schools in 2011-2012 (4:00 p.m.)
June 18, 2012	Deadline for Submitting Out-of-Area Forms to Assigned Schools for New Students to Brevard Public Schools (4:00 p.m.)
July 27, 2012	Deadline for Submitting Appeal Forms to the Office of School Choice for New Students to Brevard Public Schools (4:00 p.m.)
July 31, 2012	Out-of-Area Application Process Completed (Year Round Schools to be Completed Prior to the Beginning of the School Year)

Notes:

1. A renewal student should submit an Out-of-Area form to the school he/she is currently attending.
2. A “grandfathered” student should submit an Out-of-Area form to the school he/she is currently attending.
3. All other students should submit an Out-of-Area form to their assigned school. The assigned school is responsible for sending the form to the requested school (if recommended for approval).
4. The District 2012-13 Out-of-Area Form **MUST** be used by all students. Requests received on all other forms will not be considered.
5. A student may not register at the requested school until the Out-of-Area request has been approved by the Director of School Choice.
6. **All deadlines for submission of out-of-area forms will be strictly enforced.**
7. Approval of out-of-area requests subsequent to established deadlines will be granted for unique hardship situations and will be determined on an individual basis by the Director of School Choice.
